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RESOLUTION 07-08-08

TAPPING FEE AND CONNECTION CHARGES - UPDATE NO. 2

A RESOLUTION OF THE PETERS TOWNSHIP SANITARY AUTHORITY ESTABLISHING THE TAPPING FEE AND CONNECTION CHARGES PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPALITY AUTHORITIES ACT, 53 PS 5601, ET SEQ., AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, the Peters Township Sanitary Authority, a municipal corporation organized and existing by virtue of the "Municipality Authorities Act of 1945", 53 PS 5601 et. seq., as amended, for the purpose of providing a sanitary sewer collection, conveyance, and treatment facilities, and for providing the staffing and financing to operate said facilities; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of its financing arrangements, the Peters Township Sanitary Authority has agreed that it will charge enumerated fees to property owners who desire to or are required to connect to the authority's sewer system; and

WHEREAS, Act 57 of 2003 amended the Municipality Authorities Act (supra), and established the methodology to be used in determining the maximum tapping and connection fee that a municipal authority may charge; and

WHEREAS, the Peter's Township Sanitary Authority engaged it's engineers to compile the information required to calculate and recommend the maximum fees which were adopted on June 10, 2005.

WHEREAS, the Peter's Township Sanitary Authority has updated the original report, as supplemented, to calculate and provide a basis to change the tapping and connection fee charge to reflect current pricing and costs and to describe the methodology used in the calculation of the fees set forth therein and now desires to adopt the revised Tapping Fee and Connection Charge pursuant to the Peters Township Sanitary Authority Summary Report of Tapping Fee Calculation and Connection Charges Update No. 2.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved and enacted by the Peters Township Sanitary Authority as follows:

The Peters Township Sanitary Authority Summary Report of Tapping Fee Calculation and Connection Charges Update No. 2, including its appendices establish the basis for the Tapping Fee is hereby approved as the same is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and pursuant to same, the Tapping Fee for residential single family and multi-family dwellings where a "wye" is available shall be \$3,200 and where a "tap and saddle" is installed by the Authority the fee shall be \$3,460. The Tapping Fee for Non-Residential connections where a "wye" is available shall be \$ 91.00 plus \$ 12.05 per "gallon of capacity needed" and where a "tap and saddle" is installed by the Authority the fee shall be \$ 351.00 plus \$ 12.05 per gallon of capacity needed. The "gallons of capacity needed" shall be based upon an estimation of the maximum monthly average per day of water consumption of the proposed applicant; with a minimum of 253 gallons for each separate plumbed building. The estimation shall be calculated in accordance with Schedule A, Section E.5.

The Tapping Fee adopted herein and described above shall include the following components: connection fee; customer facilities fee; and tapping fee, including capacity and collection parts. The value for each respective component is identified in the above referenced Summary Report.

The effective date of the fees hereby adopted shall be September 1 , 2008

All other resolutions or parts thereof which are in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
