### Public Statement

**Effective June 5, 2020**

Dear community members: As many of you are aware, the presence of COVID-19 (Coronavirus) has been reported in Pennsylvania. The Peters Township Sanitary Authority (PTSA) is sensitive to the serious nature of the Coronavirus and is following guidance from the Center for Disease Control (CDC) in order to keep our employees, public officials, and citizens safe. As Washington County enters the GREEN PHASE of the Governor's Order, **the PTSA office will be REOPENED to the public at our normal business hours on June 8, 2020 with precautionary measures. Masks/face-coverings are required to enter all PTSA buildings while also practicing social distancing standards of 6 feet. Customers are encouraged to contact PTSA staff by phone or email in lieu of in face-to-face interactions.**

PTSA will resume holding its regularly scheduled public meetings in-person on June 10, 2020. While in-person public meetings resume, the public is encouraged to submit their comments or concerns to management in advance, in lieu of attendance. If you or someone you know plans to attend the meeting or visit our offices, please be sure to wash your hands prior to coming to the meeting and limit physical contact with others during the meeting. More particularly, if you are ill, we ask that you do not attend public meetings or visit our office in order to prevent the potential spread of illness to others. All attendees to PTSA Public Meetings are required to wear masks/face-coverings and practice social distancing parameters. PTSA will post continuing updates and meeting agendas online for your convenience. Billing payments can be made in-person at the PTSA office; however, customers are encouraged to make payments online through our website or by standard mail. Payments can also be left in the drop-box at the front of the office. If you require a receipt for the drop box payment, please include your invoice and note accordingly and we will stamp and mail back to you.

Dye Test Inspections and Sewer Inspections resumed on May 13, 2020. Customers or agents are encouraged to submit Dye Test Applications along with a check via the mail service or the drop box located at the front of our office. Staff will contact the applicant to schedule the dye test appointment.
