The regularly scheduled meeting of the Peters Township Sanitary Authority was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mr. Hanley reported on the DC Conveyance System Improvements project. The PaDEP had the final inspection and the PV Loan can be closed out. Mr. Jenkins reported the 18-month maintenance period has almost concluded. The new sewer system was inspected by staff and there does not appear to be any defects. The Bond can be closed out at this time.

Mr. Hanley reported the status of the Stonehenge Truck Sewer project. The 2<sup>nd</sup> attempt from the Contractor on the restoration appears to be sufficient at this time. The Conservation District will need to inspect for their approval.

Mr. Hanley reported the Zoning Hearing Board will meet on November 16, 2021 regarding the variances for the subdivision of the Churchill property related to the Piney Fork 537 planning.

### MANAGER'S REPORT: Copy on file.

Mr. Jenkins reported on the status of the BR WPCP Ultraviolet Disinfection and Phosphorus Removal Upgrades Project. Management is still waiting on the vendor to provide the performance testing report on the equipment.

Mr. Jenkins presented the Electrical Contractors Change Order No. 4. The change order is time and material associated with locating, tracing, extension and testing of the TSP Cable to the coagulate pump. The cost associated with this change order is \$395. Mr. Jenkins recommended approval of Change Order 4.

methods. Compliance with the new methods must be achieved by December 1, 2022.

Mr. Chucuddy reported the status of the McCrobie subdivision located at 475 Bower Hill Road. The ten acre lot is being subdivided into three lots. Mr. Chucuddy pointed out that of the 5 existing lots that can be served, only one is within the 150 feet requiring mandatory connection. Mr. Chucuddy recommended acceptance of the sewage flows.
